American Chemical Society (ACS)	All Max Planck authors can claim the status of an "All ACS Publications" subscribing institution when they want to make use of ACS' Open Access options - <b>no central payment by MPDL.</b> Note that ACS requires additional fees for Creative Commons Licenses.
Electrochemical Society (ECS)	Corresponding author - All Max Planck corresponding authors are eligible to use the ECS Plus Open Access option <b>without payment of article charges</b> (due to our subscription agreement).
IOS Press	Corresponding author - All Max Planck corresponding authors receive a 50% discount for article charges for IOS Press' Open Access option - <b>no</b> central payment by MPDL.
